

Respondent's vehicles enter the main gate and turn left towards the leased property and the Respondent usually parks the vehicles in front of the leased property. He submits that the Petitioner's access to erstwhile CTS Nos.154/2 and 154/3 is through the same main gate by turning right towards the two erstwhile survey numbers and there is no way that the Respondent's vehicles parked in front of the leased premises on CTS No.154/1 would block the entrance. He submits that however despite the above position, he has instructions to state that Respondent's vehicles will not block the main gate.

3. In view of the above statement, the petition stands disposed.
4. Let R.A.E. suit No.476 of 2018 proceed as per schedule.
