1. Apprehending arrest in connection with C.R. No.714 of 2023 registered with Indapur Rural Police Station, Indapur, District Pune for offences punishable under sections 306, and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, the applicants are seeking relief under section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973.
