1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned APP for the State.

2. By an order dated 18th August, 2023, this Court was persuaded to grant interim bail to the applicant as prima facie it did not appear that there was material to connect the applicant with the crime.

3. It seems that the applicant has appeared before the investigating officer and cooperated with the investigation.

4. Having regard to the nature of accusations, custodial interrogation of the applicant does not seem warranted. The

applicant appears to have roots in society. Possibility of fleeing away from justice seems remote. I am, therefore, impelled to make the order of interim bail absolute.

5. The order of interim bail dated 18th August, 2023 is made absolute on the terms and conditions incorporated therein.
