1. Learned counsel for the Petitioners states that, she had directly approached this Court and had not approached the Sessions Court by way of Criminal Revision application. She seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the Sessions Court by filing a Criminal Revision application challenging the same order of issuance of process against the Petitioners; which is the subject matter of the present petition.

2. Permission is granted. The petition is allowed to be withdrawn with liberty to the Petitioners to approach the Court of Sessions by filing a Criminal revision application. If such

application is filed, it shall be decided in accordance with law.

3. If the issue of limitation is raised, the said Court shall take into account the fact that the Petitioners were pursuing the remedy of the present writ petition before this Court. All the contentions raised in this petition are left open.

4. With the aforesaid liberty and observation, the petition is allowed to be withdrawn and is disposed of.
