1. The learned Advocate seeks leave to withdraw the application with liberty to file fresh application after six months, if there is no substantial progress in the trial. Leave with liberty as prayed for is granted.

3. It is pointed out by the learned APP that the report of analysis of the articles seized in the crime forwarded to FSL, Kalina,

FSL, Kalina should forward the report to Wadala Police Station. The Incharge of Wadala Police Station after receipt of the report shall produce the same in the Trial Court.

5. Hearing of the case is expedited. Learned Judge is directed to dispose of the same within a period of six months from the date of production of the FSL report.

6. Fees of the appointed Advocate be paid as per Rules.
