1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned APP for the State.
2. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the first informant/respondent No. 2 have amicably resolved the dispute and consent terms have been executed. The learned counsel for the applicant seeks leave to tender the consent terms.
3. Leave granted.
4. The first informant/ respondent No. 2 and the applicant are present. They admit the contents of the consent terms and the execution thereof.
5. Consent terms are taken on record and marked X.
6. The parties have, inter alia, agreed that the first informant

would accept the amount of Rs. 9 lakhs deposited by the applicant and will give consent for quashing the prosecution.

7. In view of the aforesaid statement and the consent terms (X), the order of granting interim bail dated 21st October, 2022 is made absolute.

8. The Registry to pay the amount of Rs. 9 lakhs deposited by the applicant, to the first informant/ respondent No. 2 along with interest, if any, on proper identification.
