2 Learned counsel submit that the parties have amicably resolved the dispute and consent Minutes of Order have been executed. Learned counsel seek leave to tender the consent Minutes of Order.

4 Mr.Parag Vinayak Shashtri, the authorized officer of the Petitioner and Mr.Sadashiv Namdeo Memane, the Respondent are present before the Court. They admit the contents of the consent Minutes of Order and execution thereof. They are identified by the respective counsel.
