1. Heard the learned Counsel for the parties.
2. The challenge in this Petition is to an order dated 3 October 2022 passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Baglan, Nashik, whereby the application preferred by the Petitioners to stay the effect and operation of the order passed by the Tahasildar, Baglan under Section 5 of the Mamlatdars Court Act, 1906 came to be rejected. The Mamlatdar was persuaded to allow the application preferred by Respondent Nos.3 to 6 by an order dated 4 July 2022.
3. A Revision is still awaits adjudication before the Sub-Divisional Officer, Baglan. In the circumstances, it would be expedient that the Revision application itself is finally heard and decided by the Sub-Divisional Officer.
4. The learned Counsel for Respondent Nos.3 to 6 submits that the

Respondent Nos.3 to 6 are not averse to expeditious disposal of the Revision application.

5. The Petition, thus, stands disposed with a direction to the Sub-Divisional Officer to decide the Revision Application being RTS Application No.62 of 2022 after providing an effective opportunity of hearing to the parties as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of three months from the date of appearance of the parties. The parties shall appear before the Sub-Divisional Officer, Baglan on 15 May 2023.
