- 1.** The learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner in fact is entitled to receive an amount of Rs. 3 lakhs. According to the learned advocate for respondent no. 1, an amount of Rs. 2,45,42,683/- is received from the Official Liquidator and the petitioner is paid an amount of Rs. 92,793/-. The respondent no. 1 had made a claim of Rs. 4,90,85,367/- in toto, but received an amount of Rs. 2,45,42,683.
- 2.** The petitioner has already laid the claim with the Official Liquidator. As and when the amount is received, the same is distributed accordingly on pro-rata basis. In case further amount is received, the petitioner may receive the claim.
- 3.** With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
