1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned APP for the State.
2. These applications are for relaxation of the conditions imposed by the learned Additional Session Judge while granting pre-arrest bail by an order dated 25th September, 2020.
3. Mr. Shivarkar, learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants have not approached the Court of Session for

relaxation of the conditions.
