1) In pursuance of Order dated 13th December 2022, learned Mediator Adv. Shri. Rajiv Patil has submitted his report dated 21st March, 2023 in a sealed envelope. No.687 of 2021 dated 12th November, 2021 registered with Pantnagar Police Station, Mumbai, under Sections 406, 420, 498A, 504 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Respondent No.2 is personally present in the Court and through her Advocate reiterated the contents of the said Affidavit dated 27th April 2023 and her 'no objection' for quashing of CR No.687 of 2021 registered with Pantnagar Police Station, Mumbai.
