inquiry it is found that anything which was due and payable to the Petitioners by the principal employer had not been so paid.

Learned Counsel for the Petitioners shall make an appropriate application expressing the grievances, preferably within a period of three weeks from today.

3. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
