That, the said Trimbak Chinkar was not the real father of the Petitioner. She further on instructions submitted that, there is no record to the effect that, the Petitioner deposited the key of his residential premises with the Kurar Police Station and the premises was locked by the Police of the said Police Station for the purpose of security or safety.
