2. The impugned order in the present Writ Petition is the order
dated 7th February 2023 passed by the learned Commissioner of
Fisheries @ Additional Registrar, Co-operative Society (Fisheries).

3. At the outset, Mrs. Nimbalkar, learned AGP appearing for
Respondent Nos.1 to 4 raises an objection to the maintainability
of the Writ Petition on the ground that there is an alternate
remedy of Revision available under Section 154 of the
Maharashtra Co-operative Societies Act, 1960.
