- 1) Heard the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned APP for the State.
- 2) When the application was listed before the Court on 13th November, 2023, this Court granted interim bail ascribing reasons. It was, *inter alia*, noted that the subject flat was no more mortgaged with the Bank.
- 3) The learned APP had sought time to take instructions.

- 4) Today, the learned APP on the instructions of Investigating Officer submits that the subject flat stands released from security and the Bank has issued “No Dues Certificates”.
- 5) In the aforesaid view of the matter, the order of interim bail deserves to be made absolute.
- 6) The order of Interim Bail dated 13th November, 2023 is made absolute on the terms and conditions incorporated therein.
- 7) The applicant shall henceforth appear before the Investigating Officer as and when directed.
- 8) The applicant shall regularly attend the proceedings before the jurisdictional Court.
- 9) The application stands disposed.
