1. Heard learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner.
2. By the present Writ Petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, the Petitioners are challenging the legality and validity of order dated 9th December 2021 passed by the Hon'ble Revenue Minister by which the Hon'ble Minister has granted stay to the implementation of order dated 13th October 2021 passed by the learned Additional Commissioner, Nashik Division, Nashik till the final disposal of the said proceedings.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner states that if the

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said Revision Application is disposed of in time bound manner, then he has instructions not to press the challenge to the legality and validity of the impugned order dated 9th December 2021.
