The learned Counsel for the Petitioner makes a limited request that the Petitioner's prayer for provisional release of the goods covered under the Bill of Entries specified in the prayer clause of this Petition be considered by the Respondents. The learned Counsel for the Respondents states that reply affidavit is filed.

2. We dispose of this Petition permitting the Petitioner to file an application for provisional release of the goods, which are

subject matter of the Petition, within a period of one week. Thereafter the Respondents will take a decision upon the same after giving an opportunity to the Petitioner as per law and facts within a period of two weeks, after necessary clarifications/compliances are received. Since we have indicated a timeline, it is necessary that the Respondents will pursue the matter for getting the necessary clarifications/compliances with urgency. The stand taken by the Respondents in the reply affidavit be treated as a *prima facie* opinion of the Respondents.

3. The Writ Petition is disposed of in above terms.
