1. The above Interim Application is filed seeking condonation of delay of approximately 10 days in filing the above Appeal. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Applicant/Appellant submitted that actually there is no delay because the period for filing the appeal is 90 days as per the full Bench Judgment of this Court in the case of ***Shivram Vs.
