- “ 1. By this petition filed under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, the petitioner has challenged arbitral award dated 18th July, 2019. The petition was filed on 4th November, 2019 with an application seeking condonation of delay of 16 days in filing the petition.
2. After filing of the petition and the application, the same were not been listed even once before this Court.
