1. Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submitted that she
has moved a praecipe for Court Fee exemption in
TP(L)/14511/2023.

2. Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submitted that
property has received under Probate granted in TP/
2871/2022 in pursuance of the Will executed by
Shalini Walawalkar.

3. It is appeared that property mentioned in the
probate was bequeathed to son and daughter in law
of the Shalini Walawalkar. Said Shalini was having
50% share in the said property. However, remaining

intestate. Hence, his legal heirs file the present

petition for grant of Letters of Administration or
other similar payment of Court fee is not required.
Hence, adjourned for order in TP(L)/14511/2023.
