ORDER :

1 Parties to the Arbitration Petition No.282 of 2021 have arrived at settlement. Minutes of Consent dated 01.07.2023 are tendered and taken on record and marked 'X' for identification.

2 Minutes of Consent have been signed by the Petitioner through authorised Signatory and the Advocate for the Petitioner as well as Proprietor of Respondent and the Advocate for the Respondent.

8 A soft copy of the Minutes of Consent will be uploaded as the second order in the matter.

9 The Registry is to ensure that the hard copy of the signed Minutes of Consent is permanently retained on file as part of the

record and is not sent for destruction in the ordinary course.

10 Court fees are to be refunded in accordance with the Rules. For the purposes of Section 43 of the Maharashtra Court Fees Act and the proviso to that Section, today's date is the date of making a claim for repayment. The Prothonotary & Senior Master will issue a certificate for a refund of Court Fees computed according to the Rules. He will act on production of an authenticated copy of this order without requiring a separate application.
