



5. It is stated in the petition that the legal heirship certificate is required for transfer of properties in favour of the surviving legal heirs of the deceased.

6. Having perused the material brought to the notice of this Court, the petition is accepted and proclamation is dispensed with.

7. In the interest of justice, the petition is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a), which reads as follows:

“(a) That a Legal Heirship Certificate be issued under the provision of Bombay Regulation Act VIII of 1827, certifying that petitioner, alongwith the heirs mentioned in Para 4, are the only heirs and legal representatives of the said deceased.”

8. Department is directed to expedite the issuance of legal heirship certificate.
