1] The learned counsel for the parties have filed the joint pursis under the signatures of the respective parties and their counsels, indicating that the parties have arrived at settlement, in terms of which the petitioner has undertaken to vacate the premises and hand over the possession to the respondent on or before 30.6.2023, having already received the amount of Rs. 3,00,000/- as indicated therein and being permitted to withdraw the amount deposited in the trial Court and First Appellate Court.

2] The petitioner is present in person before this Court and upon being enquired regarding the terms of the compromise pursis, has agreed to the same and its correctness.

3] The statement is accepted as a statement to the Court. The pursis is taken on record and marked as "X" for the purpose of identification. The petition is accordingly disposed off in terms of the pursis. There shall be a decree in terms of the compromise.
