Addl.GP to take instruction within how much period
the final order would be passed. On receiving the
instruction on 4.9.2023, learned Addl.GP Mr. D.P.
Thakare makes a statement that within two months

final order would be passed providedly the petitioner shall cooperate the authority in deciding the matter within stipulated time.

4. Mr. S.P. Bhandarkar, learned counsel for petitioner undertakes to cooperate the authorities in deciding the matter finally within two months. In view of the statement made by the learned Addl.GP, writ petition is disposed of. All the points are kept open.
