2. This is an application seeking to review of the order dated 17.02.2022 passed by this Court in Writ Petition No.729 of 2020 by which the petition was dismissed on account of inordinate delay of 14 years approaching to this Court for compassionate appointment.

3. Learned Counsel appearing for the review applicant would submit that during meantime there were multiple communications, which were also tendered on record.
