2] We find that the petitioner has approached the Debts Recovery Tribunal, Nagpur by filing Securitization Application No. 50/2021. It is open for the petitioner to seek the prayers as raised in this Writ Petition before the Debts Recovery Tribunal. Further remedy of appeal is also available to the petitioner if it is aggrieved by the order dated 20/10/2022 passed by the Debts Recovery Tribunal.

3] In that view of the matter, we are not inclined to entertain the Writ Petition. It is disposed of. All points raised in the Writ Petition are kept open.
