Present application is filed for condonation of delay in filing restoration application in MCA Stamp No. 24267/2017. There is delay of 1192 days in filing restoration application. The reason given for the delay is delay on the part of earlier Advocates. The reasons given for condonation of delay, is not satisfactory at all. However, in the interest of justice, the delay needs to be condoned. As no due diligence on the part of client or Advocate shown, it is subject to costs

of Rs.10,000/-, to be deposited with the Government Pleader's Library within a period of three weeks.
