By this application, appellant is seeking condonation of delay of 62 days which is caused in filing the appeal against the judgment and award passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Chandrapur.

As per the contention of the appellant, the appellant is the Insurance Company and the officials of the Branch office has to obtain the necessary approvals from their higher officials wherein time is consumed, and therefore the delay is caused.

The learned Advocate appearing for the respondent No.2 raised objection on the ground that there is no justifiable and reason for condonation of delay.

Reply filed by the respondent No.2 is taken on record.

Perused the application and submissions of both sides. Considering the reasons mentioned in the application that necessary approvals are required to be taken wherein the time is consumed, the delay of 62 days is condoned.
