This is an application for condonation of delay in filing restoration application. Delay is of 374 days.

It is the case of the petitioner that inadvertently objections were not removed and accordingly, for non-removal of office objections, registration of was refused and the petition was dismissed.

However, the petitioner had no knowledge about the same and therefore, after receipt of the knowledge, the application for restoration was moved.

With the reasons stated in the application, I am satisfied that the sufficient cause is shown and therefore, though the learned

AGP opposes the present application, I am of the opinion that the application should be allowed with costs.

Accordingly, I pass the following order:

The application is **allowed**, subject to deposit of Rs.2,000/- towards costs with the High Court Legal Services Sub-Committee, Nagpur.
