1. The only prayer made in the writ petition is a direction to be issued to the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to decide the petitioner's One Time Settlement proposal.

She submits that though copy of the same has been served on the petitioner, another copy of the order rejecting the proposal would be served on the petitioner within a period of one week from today.
