The learned counsel for the appellant to serve the respondent no. 4 by RPAD on the given address as the partner i.e. respondent no. 3 who was representing a partnership firm is no more alive.

3. The learned counsel for the appellant is also permitted to serve the respondent no. 4 by any other mode available as per law.
