In spite of service, none appears for the proposed legal heirs of respondent no. 7.

2. The present application is filed for condonation of 1487 days' delay in filing the application for setting aside abatement and for bringing the legal heirs of respondent no. 7 on record.

3. For the reasons stated in the application, the application is allowed.

4. The appellants are permitted to bring the names of legal heirs of respondent no. 7 on record.

6. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of.

SECOND APPEAL NO. 314 OF 2015
