2. This is an application seeking to quash the proceeding vide RCC No.480 of 2005 arising out of crime No.3379 of 2005 registered with the Lakadganj Police Station, District Nagpur for the offence punishable under Sections 294, 506-B of the Indian Penal Code, on account of settlement.

3. It is informed that the Trial Court has recorded the evidence of five witnesses as well as recorded the statement of accused in terms of Section 313 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. At this juncture, with the aid and

intervention of relatives, the matter is settled and therefore, both have urged to quash the proceedings.

4. The non-applicant no.2 is present in the Court through her Advocate and filed her affidavit stating that matter is amicably settled.
