It is brought to my notice that learned Single Judge (Vacation Court) at Aurangabad has by way of *ad interim relief* stayed the termination order of the petitioners in Writ Petition (Stamp) No.36540/2023 and other group matters, who are stated to be similarly placed. Considering the said fact, termination order is stayed till the next date of hearing.
