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### **ORDER**

2. The petitioner seeks issuance of certified copy of extract from the permanent land register for his land situated in Survey Nos.36/3 to 36/43, Nungambakkam Village, Egmore, Nungambakkam Taluk, Chennai District as claimed in his representation dated 13.09.2022.

3. Heard Mr.V.K.Vijayaragavan learned counsel for the petitioner and Mrs.N.Senthilselvi, learned Government Advocate for the respondents.

4. Learned Government Advocate would submit that, the said request of the petitioner through his representation dated 13.09.2022 would be considered and necessary orders would be passed thereon on merits and in accordance with law within a time frame that may be stipulated by this Court.



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5. Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for herein and having regard to the stand of the learned Government Advocate, this Court is inclined to dispose of this writ petition with the following order.

“That there shall be a direction to the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 13.09.2022 and pass necessary orders thereon with regard to the plea raised therein after hearing the petitioner, on merits and in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.”

6. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
