ORDER

The Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 27.12.2022 in seeking permission for conducting cultural programme (Adal Padal) for the temple festival of

District scheduled to be held on 16.01.2023.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of temple festival of Arulmigu Sri Mari Amman Tiru Koil at Mottur Village, Valaiyathur, Ranipet District on 16.01.2023 between 06.00 PM to 11.00 PM, the petitioner has sent a representation dated 27.12.2022 to the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

5.It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a Circular Memorandum in



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Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 27.12.2022 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
