This petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 301 days in representing the above said Civil Revision Petition in C.R.P.SR.No.117599 of 2021 before this court.

2. Mr.Thomas T.Jacob, learned counsel for petitioners submitted that the above petition was returned for compliance of certain defects. However, the 1st petitioner was suffered from Covid and thereafter he landed up with post covid complications and facing prolonged sickness, due to which, he was not able to approach his counsel to prefer this petition. However, due to lack of communication to the counsel, he was not able to represent the petition in time.
