ORDER

The Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondents to grant permission and protection to the Pongal Sports Activities conducted at Makkripalayam Village outside, Nallenasamy Land, set to take place on 16.01.2023 and 17.01.2023, based on the petitioner's representation dated 07.01.2023.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct cultural programme on 16.01.2023 and 17.01.2023, in the Pongal Sports Activities conducted at Makkripalayam Village outside, Nallenasamy Land, the petitioner has sent a representation, dated 07.01.2023 to the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the second respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 07.01.2023 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
