COMMON ORDER

These Writ Petitions have been filed to direct the 2nd and 3rd respondents herein to approve forthwith the appointment of 4 teaching staff (3 Assistant Professors and 1 Librarian) and 15 Assistant Professors in the petitioner college and disburse the grant-in-aid towards their salary and allowances with effect from the original dates of their respective appointments.



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2.It the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that though the clarification sought by the respondents has been addressed, no order has been passed in approving the appointment.

3.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr.M.Alagu Gowtham, learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents 1 to 3 and Mrs.V.Sudha, learned Standing Counsel for the fourth respondent.

4.Since no order has been passed in approving the appointment, this Court cannot give positive direction to grant approval. The Authorities shall pass an order on its own merits within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5.With the above direction, these Writ Petitions are disposed of. No costs. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
