PRAYER: Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issue of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records relating to the first respondent herein in G.O.(3D) No. 105, Agriculture (AA-II (2) Department dated 27.05.2011 and the consequential order passed to retain the petitioner in service on reaching the age of superannuation in



G.O.(3D) No. 106 Agriculture (AA-II (2) Department dated 27.05.2011 and quash the same and consequently direct the respondents herein to retire the petitioner from service with effect from 31.05.2011 and confer the pension and other retirement benefits with due regards to the petitioner seniority.

ORDER

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the Writ Petition has been filed challenging the suspension order and the order not permitting him to retire.

2. The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 submitted that subsequently an order has been passed by the first respondent in G.O. (3D) No. 21 dated 09.02.2019 awarding punishment of compulsory retirement.



3. The learned counsel for the petitioner has also made the following endorsement to that effect:-

“since compulsory retirement punishment was awarded, this Writ Petition becomes infructuous. Hence, the same may be dismissed as infructuous.”

4. In view of the endorsement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and also the submissions made by the learned Additional Government Pleader, this Writ Petition stands dismissed as infructuous. Consequently, connected Civil Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
