This case came up for settlement before the National Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. The learned counsel for the appellant M/s.A.Subedra for Ms.Ramya V.Rao and the learned counsel for the second respondent Mr.Vinod and the learned counsel for the fourth respondent Mr.C.Johnson are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

Both the parties and their respective counsel are present.

2. The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.14,10,000/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakhs Ten Thousand only) (Rs.7,05,000 + Rs.7,05,000) with interest at 7.5% p.a. from the date of petition till the date of deposit as compensation.

3. Aggrieved by the award, the appellants have preferred the present appeal. Now the appellants/claimants have agreed to receive a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only) in full quit, in addition to the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, which is also acceptable by the second and fourth respondents equally.



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4. The second and fourth respondents are directed to deposit the award amount, now ordered, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Award is passed accordingly. On such deposit, the claimants are permitted to withdraw the Award amount as per the apportionment mentioned supra, after deducting the amount already withdrawn by the claimants, if any.

5. The Tribunal is directed to issue the award amount through NEFT/RTGS to the party concerned on proper identification in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition.

6. The appeal is ordered accordingly. Consequently, the connected MP, if any, is closed.
