2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that “Thai Poosam Festival” is scheduled on 01.02.2023 at Arulmighu Mangammal Mahalakshmi Temple with a rally from Kathirimalai to Erode and again to Kathirimalai Temple. The respondents 3 to 5 are obstructing the conduct of festival. Therefore, this petition.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 submitted that the petitioner gave a representation on 20.12.2022 which is pending consideration.
