Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ of habeas corpus to call for the entire records relating to petitioner's son detention under Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982 vide detention order dated 30.12.2022 on the file of the second respondent herein made in proceedings C3/D.O.No.62/2022 and quash the same as illegal and consequently, direct the respondents herein to produce the said petitioner's son namely, Ranjith, aged 38 years, son of Vijayan before this Hon'ble High Court and set him at liberty, now petitioner's son detained at Central Prison, Vellore.
