PRAYER: Civil Suit filed under Order XXIV Rule 1 & 2 of Madras High Court O.S.Rules read with Order VII Rule 1 of CPC & 151 CPC, praying to pass a decree and judgement,against the defendants 1 to 3 and each one of them

(a)for partition and separate possession of the plaintiff's one fourth share of the properties set out in schedule 'A' to 'D' properties of the plaintiff and directing the defendants to hand over the possession of the same to the plaintiff;

(b)to direct the defendants 1 to 3 and each one of the defendants to render account of the amounts invested in FDs in the name of late T.M.Rangarajan and in their name of defendants 1 to 3 and any one of them and in respect of income and rents received by defendants from Schedule A, B & C properties and to pas a decree for the amount so ascertained and to



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pay the plaintiff's one-fourth share thereon.

(c) to direct the defendants to pay the cost of the suit

(d) and to pass such further reliefs as this Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.
