When this was pointed out to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he will withdraw this Writ Petition with a liberty to file separate Writ Petitions for all the petitioners.



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2. This Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn and liberty is granted to file separate Writ Petitions. There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
