This case is taken up for settlement before this Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. Mr.D.Bhaskaran, learned counsel for appellant and Ms.V.Ramya V.Rao, learned counsel for the first respondent are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

**TERMS OF SETTLEMENT**

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The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.10,48,361/- with interest at the rate of 12% per annum as compensation to the first respondent/claimant. Challenging the same, the appellant/Insurance Company has preferred this appeal.

2. The award amount of Rs.10,48,361/- with interest has been already deposited by the appellant. After due deliberation and consultation, both the parties have agreed for a settlement of a sum of Rs.8,00,000/- (Rupees Eight Lakhs Only) in full quit and the same is hereby, awarded. The award is modified accordingly.

3. The first respondent/claimant is permitted to withdraw the modified award amount of a sum of Rs.8,00,000/- (Rupees Eight Lakhs Only) in full quit. The remaining deposited amount shall be permitted to withdraw by the appellant/Insurance Company.

4. Accordingly, the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of.
