These petitions are filed (i) to condone the delay of 174 days in filing the petition to set-aside the order of the abatement caused due to the death of the sole appellant (ii) to set-aside the order of the abatement caused due to the death of the sole appellant (iii) to bring on record the legal heirs of the deceased sole appellant and rank them as appellants 2 to 6 in the above appeal, respectively.
