Union of India and another, (2010) 7 SCC 202***, and the same has been negatived by the Apex Court and the manner of operation of the said Article is also dealt with by the Apex Court in the case of ***Vikas Kishanrao Gawali v. State of Maharashtra, reported in (2021) 6 SCC 73***.

3. In view of that, the writ petitions stand dismissed. No costs.
