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appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner Management had absorbed the 2nd respondent in all the Writ Petitions on 18.06.2016 as Field Assistant as per B.P.No.17. In support of his contention, he produced a memo dated 04.02.2023.

4.Recording the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and also the fact that a memo dated 04.02.2023 has also been filed before this Court, the Writ Petitions stands dismissed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
