COMMON ORDER

These writ petitions have been filed challenging the proceedings of the first respondent in respective Calendar Cases .

2. Heard, the learned counsel appearing on either side.

3. On perusal of records, revealed that challenging the order passed by the third respondent, the petitioners filed a batch of writ petitions W.P.Nos.2329, 2330, 2331, 2332, 2333, 14026, 7516, 7552 and 7517 of 2000. 4874 to 4878 of 2001, 8338 to 8340 of 2001, 18292, 18302, 18307, 18314, 26084 of 2001, 7298 and 7304 of 2000, 26969 of 2003, 17768 of 2004, 7004 of 2000 and 22799 to 22802 of 2001 before this Court and this Court by an order dated 29.01.2020, dismissed the same. Aggrieved by the same, the petitioners filed writ appeals in



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W.A.Nos. 1141, 1142, 1143, 1151, 1152, 1153, 1154, 1155 & 1203 of 2011. Pending writ appeals, the second respondent initiated prosecution before the first respondent for non implementing the order of grant of permanency of workers against the petitioners, which are challenged in these writ petitions. In the meanwhile, pending these writ petitions, all writ appeals were dismissed. Now it is informed that the petitioners and the workers in the presence of the second respondent and other officials have entered into settlement.

4. In view of the above settlement, these writ petitions are closed. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
